



October 15, 2018 Be An Example

Paul instructed Timothy not to let anyone look down on him because he was young, but to be "an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity" (1 Tim 4:12). The reminder is a good one: we can't really do anything about our age (either adding years or taking them off!), but we can live an exemplary life of Christlikeness. While this is a challenge for our second language skills, we find it much easier talking with one or two people across the table than trying to
